Sibling Concessions

Sibling concessions are calculated on the number of students from the same household who are attending the school or Pacific Coast Christian School at the same time. The second student attract a 50% concession and a 100% concession to further students, excluding Prep students. Sibling concessions are not offered for cross school enrolments with Pacific Online Christian School.

- Term invoices are issued for Tuition fees and are payable by the end of the first week of each term.**

- Withdrawal notice** - Per the School's enrolment contract, one term written notice to the principal is required with intention to withdraw students. An assessment of loss suffered as result of insufficient notice, up to one term's fees, may be charged.
